Registration and Price

Fee is CAD 3 000 per person for companies with fewer than 50 employees and a turnover of less than 10 Million EURO. (Price for 2nd person from same company is CAD 1.500)

Fee is CAD 5 000 per person for companies larger than above mentioned. (Price for 2nd person from same company or organization is CAD 3.000
