Five European cluster partners have established a long-term strategic agreement: Tretorget (Norway), ByggDialog (Sweden), InnoBYG (Denmark), ecoplus (Austria) and Sustainable Infrastructure Cluster (Poland) have competences that supplement each other. SE is strong in energy efficiency, NO is strong in wood construction, AT is strong in wood construction and cross sector collaboration, PL is strong in affordable energy+ solution and DK is strong in bio-based materials and recycling of building materials.
