










The initiative for the study comes from the Nordic Environmental Protection Agencies, and has been put in effect through the Nordic Council of Ministers waste group - NAG. Aim of the project is to inspire all actors within the sector, and that the selected best practices will be used as the first step in a practical implementation of both waste prevention methods and measures to reduce generation of waste in the construction industry. COWI + CRI was hired to conduct an assessment of initiatives to prevent waste from the building and construction sector. The report comprises experience and practises from the Nordic countries, and the main findings will be presented at the seminar.

Directions to COWI office in Lyngby:

COWI's head office is situated approximately 20 km north of Copenhagen Airport and 150 m from Lyngby railway station.

Transport by taxi from Copenhagen Airport:

Approximately 25 minutes, price approximately DKK 450 / EURO 60.

Transport by train:

Copenhagen Airport-Lyngby, approximately 40 minutes, price approximately DKK 50 / EURO 7.

You can either:

- a) take the train from the airport in the direction of Helsingør and change trains at Hellerup station to the S-train (they are the big, red trains) in the direction of Hillerød or Holte and get off at Lyngby station. or
- **b)** take the Metro from the airport to Nørreport Station and take an S-train in the direction of Hillerød or Holte. Get off at Lyngby.

COWI is situated 150 m from Lyngby railway station.

Exit the station via the underground walkway in the opposite direction to the main town, then bear left towards the tall office buildings. Keep left by the railway tracks and follow the path beside the building.

This will lead you to our main reception.
